Job Overview

Performs a wide variety of custodial and maintenance duties in and around campus facilities in order to provide a clean, orderly and safe environment for the students. Troubleshoots and performs repairs and responds to emergency calls for service, implements setup and takedown for a wide variety of campus and community events.

Major Duties and Responsibilities (the following list is not meant to be exhaustive nor restrictive in nature but instead is meant to provide examples)

- Diagnose and perform maintenance and repairs to multiple school buildings
- Conduct basic carpentry such as repairing/installing drywall, cabinets, furniture, fences, and window panes
- Repair plumbing, electrical and safety systems
- Implement maintenance and repairs on doors, locks, and hinges
- Maintain and repair roofs, drainage, and irrigation systems, walkways, stairs, stucco, parking surfaces, and similar building components
- Repair equipment, appliances, and purchasing supplies as needed
- Respond to maintenance requests in a timely and professional manner using our online tracking tool
- Set up and move equipment and furniture as needed for events
- Organize school furniture and materials and repair or dispose of as necessary
- May be required to clean and sanitize restrooms during the school day
- Respond to alarm triggers, interact with alarm company as needed
- Operates and makes all installations and repairs in accordance with local, state and national codes
- Participate in off-shift and weekend emergency maintenance coverage as needed

Job Qualifications and personal skills

- Must have at least 2 years of maintenance experience
- Must have knowledge in electrical, plumbing, HVAC, drywall, painting, and carpentry
- Must be a team player and must have a positive can-do attitude
- Must have a consistent work history and verifiable references
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must be detail and quality-oriented, and dedicated to complete follow-through.

- Must be available to work weekends and evenings when needed.
- Must possess and maintain a valid California Driver's License. Must have a clean driver's record.
- Must be able to pass a background search.

Working conditions:

- Position requires repeated movement (walking, bending, kneeling, stooping, crouching, climbing, lifting etc...) operating and maintaining construction tools and equipment.
- Position requires the ability to safely lift and carry a minimum of 60 pounds on a regular basis and up to 100 pounds on occasions.
- Position may require wearing protective clothing and equipment for extended periods of time.
- Willingness to have a flexible schedule, and available to work weekends on occasion
- May work under dusty and noisy conditions.
- Routinely required to work under inclement weather conditions.
